Location.	All Friends of the Lake District sites – you choose which sites
Your Role.	To visit and check Friends of the Lake District sites to ensure safety, accessibility, cleanliness and to recognise problems or danger and report back to 'Friends' staff for action.
What's in it for you?	Fresh air, access to some beautiful sites, meet people onsite who may be visiting the area, meet 'Friends' staff who may be onsite. A fully flexible opportunity and a great way to get outdoors.
Time commitment.	1-2 visits per month, fully flexible around your schedule. We ask that you let us know of any visits and issues.
Duration.	30 mins – 1 hour, site specific
